



Antonella Coco, starting from 19 December 2022, is assistant professor at Center for Higher Defence Studies (CASD) – School of Advanced Defence Studies, for the scientific disciplinary sector SPS/11 Sociology of Political Phenomena.

In 2018, she obtained the National Scientific Qualification as an associate professor in the scientific-disciplinary sector SPS/11 - Sociology of Political Phenomena.

Graduated in Economic and Social Disciplines from the University of Calabria, she obtained a Master of Research in European Social Policy from the University of Bath (UK) and subsequently a Ph.D. in Politics, Society, and Culture from the University of Calabria. At the same university, she carried out a three-year Post-Doc, awarded through a competitive selection process, in the disciplinary sector SPS/11 - Sociology of Political Phenomena in cooperation with the Centre d'études européennes - Sciences Po (Paris), where she spent a year as visiting fellow. She has been a research fellow at the Department of Political and Social Sciences of the University of Calabria, where she obtained both university research fellowship through competitive selection and research fellowship within national research projects (PRIN).

She carried out individual research and she participated in National Research Projects (PRIN), funded by the Ministry of University and Research, as well as in activities of various research groups. Her main research interests focus on cities as political institutions, transformations of political power, and particularly phenomena such as neopatrimonialism, populism, clientelism, and the personalization of politics in regional systems.

She has carried out teaching activities at the University of Calabria as contract lecturer of "Political Power" and "Politics and Society," and "Social Regulation and Security" in the Master's degree program in Political Sciences. She has been thesis advisor and member of thesis committees within the Department of Political and Social Sciences at the University of Calabria. She has also served as a member of a committee for the final evaluation of doctoral theses at the Centre Maurice Halbwachs - École des Hautes Études en Sciences Sociales - Doctoral School No. 286 - Paris.

She has participated in national and international conferences, particularly at conferences organized by the AIS Section of Political Sociology, ESA, ISA RC26, Espanet, SISP, and WCSA. She has conducted seminars at the University of Salerno, the Cattaneo Institute, and the Centre Maurice Halbwachs - École des Hautes Études en Sciences Sociales - Paris.

She is a member of the scientific committee of the editorial series "Sociologia Politica," published by Rubbettino, Soveria Mannelli (CZ). She has been referee for national and international journals. She is the secretary of the AIS section (Italian Association of Sociology) - Sociology of Political Phenomena for the 2023-2026 term.
