

Alessandro Pompei was born in Bracciano on November 10, 1992. Starting from 16 January 2023 he is an assistant professor at the Center for Higher Defence Studies (CASD) – School of Advanced Defence Studies, for the scientific disciplinary sector ING-IND/35. Graduated in Management Engineering at the University of Rome Sapienza in 2016, in the academic year 2020/2021 he obtained the title of PhD in Management Engineering at the University of Rome Sapienza (XXXIII Cycle). During the PhD period, he deepened, from a scientific-academic point of view, issues concerning the discipline of Project Management, having also had the opportunity to develop its practice by working in parallel with various European and University

research projects. In the same period, he provided organizational/managerial support to professional specialization courses (masters/training courses), as well as to the Monitoring Committee at the same university where the PhD period was carried out. From 1 May 2021 to 16 December 2022 he carried out research activities as a research fellow for quality assessment and monitoring in complex projects within the CIVIS - A European Civic University project co-funded by Erasmus+ programme of the European Union at the Department of Computer, Control and Management Engineering "Antonio Ruberti" of Sapienza University of Rome.

He has participated in numerous European, national and public and private research projects.

Alessandro Pompei carries out research on topics related to Project Management and Sustainability. He originally adopts the research methodology of modeling and simulation based on systemic approaches, applied in various areas including Organization Management, Public Policy Evaluation, Climate Change.

He is the author of 25 international publications, as well as a contributor to an international book: "Urban Sustainability, a Game-Based Approach" (Springer); and two books with national circulation: "Industry 4.0 - Between emerging suggestions and effective solutions" (Edizioni Nuova Cultura) and "The Charm of Precarity.
